## **FULL PAPER GUIDELINES**

- 1. All speakers qualified for the conference must submit a full, written paper of their presentation. The paper should be translated to a professional standard and be reviewed by your supervisor(s).
- 2. Papers cannot exceed 9 000 characters with spaces (5 standard pages), including bibliography.
- 1. Use **Times New Roman 12**, **1,5 line spacing**, **2,5 cm margins** on both sides.
- 2. Insert page numbers at the bottom right corner.
- 3. Split the body of text into paragraphs. Start each one with a tab-key. Do not use columns, breaking or folding. Justify the text.
- 4. If you want to use **subtitles** before paragraphs choose Times New Roman 12 Bold (see example below).
- 5. At the beginning of the article insert name of author(s), title, full name of your institution and department, name of supervisor(s) (including academic title), according to the formula:

## **AUTHOR'S NAME**

## Title of article

Full Name of Institution and Department Supervisor(s): Name(s) with academic title

## Subtitle

- 6. The text should include links to drawings/photos in brackets, for example: "the panel painting (Fig. 1) is owned...".
- 7. **Footnotes** to the text should be placed at the bottom of the page, not at the end of the article. Use font Times New Roman 9 (see example above).
- 8. Include **References** at the end of the paper.

- 9. Use **Oxford referencing style** for your bibliography and footnotes. Check the reference guidelines on the conference website to see how to prepare them correctly (www.wk.asp.krakow.pl/conference-call/).
- 10. **Drawings/photos** should be included **in separate files** ( .jpg or .tiff format). Resolution of **300ppi**. Make sure that the photos will be readable in print. All **photos should be entitled with the name of the first author and a number corresponding to that given in the text.** Remember to have a permission to publish photos that have not been taken by the author(s) of the article.
- 11. After References **list the descriptions of all attached figures** according to the formula:
  - Fig. 1. Description of the figure. Photo: Author name, date.
  - Fig. 2. The gothic panel painting; state after conservation. *Photo: J. Smith*, 2019.
- 12. The **paper and files with figures** should be send to the organizer via e-mail: <a href="mailto:conference.wkirds@gmail.com">conference.wkirds@gmail.com</a> by 30th October 2019. Save the text file in \*.doc or \*.docx format (Microsoft Word) and put your last name in the title of the file (for example SMITH.doc).
